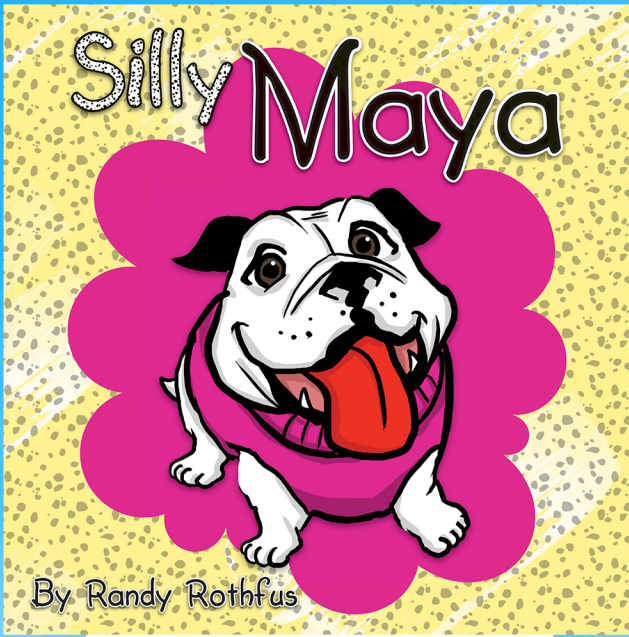


Silly Maya
